Minutes of a meeting of Shalfleet Parish Council held in the Newbridge Community Centre on Wednesday 11th April 2007 at 1915 hrs.

99/06-7 APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr.M.Carr.

100/06-7 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

There were none at this point.

101/06-7 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING.

RESOLUTION: The minutes of the previous meeting having been circulated were confirmed and the Chairman authorised to sign them as a true record.

Proposed: Cllr.Mrs Broadhead. Seconded Cllr.Burt. Passed.

102/06-7 MATTERS ARISING NOT REQUIRING A RESOLUTION.

Ref89/06-7 The Clerk reported that IWC Planning enforcement had advised that Laburnham Cottage was granted permission for the new entrance in 2005.

Ref98/06-7 The Clerk advised that a Highway condition report has been sent to and acknowledged by the IWC regarding medial road ridges at Ningwood Hill.

At this point in the meeting the Chairman being aware of public concern regarding the next agenda item (proposed new cycle routes) suspended standing orders at 1920 hrs to allow free public discussion. Standing orders were restored at 1941 hrs.

Cllr.Baxandall declared an interest prior to the council discussing agenda item 5 (proposed cycle routes).

103/06-7 PROPOSED CYCLEWAY.

The council further debated this item taking in fresh representations made by members of the public during the foregoing free discussion period.

RESOLUTION : It was agreed the previous resolution (minute 20/06-7) made on the 14th June 2006 remains extant in its entirety.

104/06-7 ONE MILLION BLOOMS PROJECT

The Chairman advised on progress with this project, he listed arrangements for future expenditure agreed with Mr.Goodenough (IWC) as follows- £1000 to fund supply of saplings. £500 to fund contract equipment hire,materials etc. Cllr Hedgley reported that the IWC would order and store the saplings till required for planting.

105/06-7 CLERKS REPORT

- a) Finance. **RESOLUTION** a list of payments (prior circulated) was agreed, details as follows £69.89 Brighstone Landscaping,£41.13 Island Copier Co. £32.41 expenses ,Clerks salary.

The Council noted the content of a memorandum from the Clerk listing the fiscal effects caused by his resignation from Rookley and Chale Parish Councils and the consequential ceasing of shared expenses regarding travel and broadband provision.

- b) Administration.: The Clerk reported the content of an email requesting permission to restore a memorial seat situated on the approach to Shalfleet Quay, this was granted subject to the necessary notice being given to the National Trust as landowner.

The Clerk gave notice to members of a proposal to amend financial standing order 17 to insert the word **seek** between the words possible and three.which will require approval at the AGM.before the usual reaffirmation of standing orders.

The Clerk advised members of several other minor administrative items.
