## 23/05-6 COUNCILLORS REPORTS

**Cllr.W.R.Burt CC** reported that effects of the recent taxi de-regulation were currently being monitored by the IWC, Cllr Burt also advised that concern was being generated regarding the adequacy and surfacing of the Island's highways and road infrastructure. There were no immediate local items for report.

Cllr Burt advised that Yarmouth Town Council will shortly be asking for support regarding a **Quiet Lane Status** application.

**Cllr Mrs Broadhead** reported local concern regarding dog fouling of the Bouldnor Sports Field, it was pointed out that new installation of litter and dog litter bins now incur a heavy charge on the Parish Council for supply and emptying. It was agreed the Clerk should prepare a letter for local circulation requesting the co-operation of local residents in this matter. Cllr Mrs Broadhead also advised the RCC had invited an application from SPC for a Community Action Award, the Clerk undertook to process this.

The **Vice-Chairman** reported local drainage problems in S16 Dark Lane at intersection with former railway line.

**Cllr Carr** reported the construction of a large building behind Orchard Croft, Wellow and queried whether it had the benefit of planning consent.

**The Chairman** reported his attendance with the Clerk at a recent Parish & Town Council Planning Forum, he reported this meeting to be extremely well attended and

that a further meeting was to be held in the Autumn to monitor the determination figures of the LPA and consider planning and enforcement issues raised at the first meeting.

Members were reminded that the next **ordinary meeting** would be held on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2005 at Newbridge Social Club.
