63/06-7 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING.

The minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed and the Chairman signed them as a true record.

64/06-7 MATTERS ARISING NOT REQUIRING A RESOLUTION.

Ref41/06-7 The Clerk reported the broken finger post at Main Road Newbridge/Dodpits Intersection has been repaired.

65/06-7 BOULDNOR FIELD PROJECT-YARMOUTH FC LETTER.

The Clerk reported current progress in fund raising and the Bouldnor field project, he also reported the content of a letter from Yarmouth & Calbourne FC requesting the revival of their request for accommodation within the Bouldnor field. A lengthy debate then followed with members considering other demands on the field that have arisen in recent years such as Yarmouth Old Gaffers "Park & Ride" and the logistics of the playground project location vis-à-vis the requirements of the *Crime & Disorder Act*.

RESOLUTION: That the Council considers the requirements of the Bouldnor project and the Park & Ride should have first priority and when the project has been completed the Council will then consider the request for accommodation by the Football Club.

67/06-7 TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING.

Due to the low attendance of members and Cllr.Burt's role on the IWC Planning Committee the Council was unable to receive this item being inquorate, following the rising of the Council the Clerk liaised with members and submitted recommendations on behalf of the Council using delegated powers conferred by standing order 14. A list of the delegated recommendations is appended to these minutes.

68/06-7 COUNCILLORS REPORTS

Cllr.Burt.CC advised of his concern regarding further government cuts in Post Office provision and indicated he was raising the matter with the IWC Cabinet.

Cllr.Carr Reminded members that 2007 will mark H.M the Queen's diamond wedding and it might be appropriate to consider some special provision to celebrate the event. Mr Carr advised that three millennium signs in the Thorley Brook are still to be provided and he was currently getting estimates.

It was reported the bridge in Hill Place Lane (out of parish) was in urgent need of attention Cllr Burt CC as Ward Councillor undertook to advise IWC Highways.

The Chairman enquired if any response had been received from SW Housing following the recent meeting, the Clerk was requested to communicate with the Housing association to enquire progress regarding parking provision.
