### **Statement of Intent (Training)**

Shalfleet Parish Council has for many years supported the principle of training for Councillors and Clerks serving in the 1<sup>st</sup> tier of local government. The Council was pleased to participate in the first years of the Quality Parish scheme in 2005 being amongst the smallest and earliest councils to achieve quality status on the Isle of Wight.

The Council agrees to encourage Members and The Clerk, where possible, to attend training events that will enhance their knowledge of good governance and best practise. The Council will support the continuous professional development of its Clerk by subscribing to membership of the Society of Local Council Clerks and the Institute of Local Council Management.

The Council will take note of any future recommendations regarding training as may be published by NALC/SLCC

An appropriate annual budget figure for training and seminar costs shall be included in the pre-budget /precept estimates each year.

The Chairman will include in his annual report a statement regarding the scope of the past years training and the Clerks CPD record (if qualified)
